Recommendations

Based on the examination findings, family history and experience with similar cases, your child is a candidate for myopia treatment. The goal of treatment will be to reduce future progression of myopia as much as possible; reducing your child's need for stronger vision correction year after year and attempting to reduce the risk of other serious eye diseases (for example glaucoma, retinal detachments and others) often associated with myopia.

Recommended treatment is spectacles lens

Custom spectacles lenses look and feel like regular eyeglass lenses, but feature an innovative lens design clinically proven to slow down the progression of myopia by reducing eye elongation (axial length growth).

This treatment is ideal for children who are not ready for contact lenses or whose parents prefer a spectacle-based option for myopia control. Spectacle lenses provide clear, comfortable vision for everyday wear while managing myopia progression.

Next steps for spectacle lens treatment for myopia control

After payment is received, we will design and order the appropriate custom spectacles. It takes approximately four weeks to have them made and delivered to our office. At that time, your child and a parent/guardian will be scheduled for a fitting and education session to ensure proper wear, care, and use. Your child should wear the custom spectacle lenses daily, ideally for 12 or more hours per day.

Fees for treatment

The fees charged are a total comprehensive fee. The fee is not dependent on the exact number of visits or lenses used. Appointments will be made as often as necessary to accomplish our mutual goal of slowing down the progression of myopia.

Fees for the first two-years of treatment

Payment Plan A - CareCredit

\$206 per month for 24 months

Payment Plan B

\$4537 one time payment (covers 24 months)

This fee includes

- Consultation, corneal bio-microscopy, corneal topography mapping, retinal imaging, and axial length measurements
- As many visits as needed for two years to ensure proper eye health and optimal myopia management. We provide concierge service during the treatment program.
- Four pairs of frame (\$500 per year) and custom spectacle lenses (two dispensed each year)
- Concierge service and myopia education throughout the treatment
- Warranty on custom spectacle lens and frame breakage (50%)

This fee does not include

- Lost spectacle lens.

Renewal fee for year three of treatment

\$917*

Renewal fee subject to change after year three

This fee includes

- Corneal bio-microscopy, corneal topography mapping, retinal imaging and axial length measurements.
- As many visits as may be needed to ensure proper eye health and ongoing optimal myopia management. We provide concierge service during the treatment program.
- One pair spectacle lens and frame (\$250 frame allowance)
